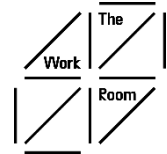


Barrowland Ballet & The Work Room Recent Dance Graduate Programme 2019

We especially welcome applications from those who identify as having characteristics currently under-represented within the dance sector in Scotland.

Applications will be reviewed by the Artistic Director of Barrowland Ballet and the Director of The Work Room, with all applicants informed of the outcome no later than 1 October 2019.
